

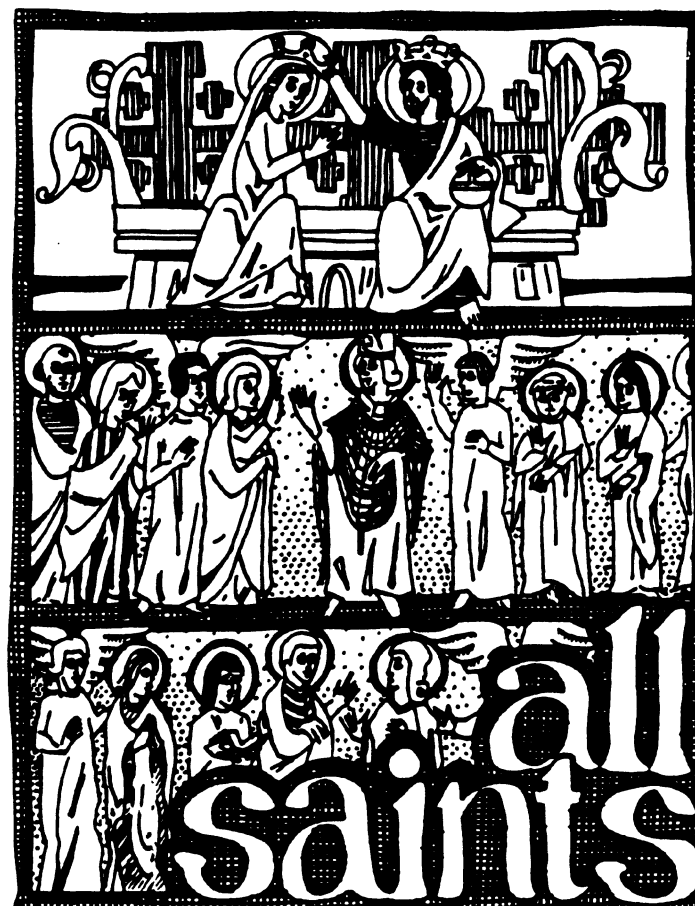

NOVEMBER 7th WILLIBRORD (c. 658-7 November 739) was a Northumbrian missionary saint, known as the “Apostle to the Frisians” in what is now the Netherlands. He became the first Bishop of Utrecht and died at Echternach, Luxembourg.

NOVEMBER 11th MARTIN OF TOURS (316 or 336 - 11 November 397) was Bishop of Tours, whose shrine in France became a famous stopping-point for pilgrims on the road to Santiago de Compostela in Spain. While Martin was a soldier in the Roman army and stationed in Gaul (modern-day France), he experienced a vision, which became the most-repeated story about his life. One day as he was approaching the gates of the city of Amiens, he met a scantily clad beggar. He impulsively cut his military cloak in half to share with the man. That night, Martin dreamed of Jesus wearing the half-cloak he had given away. He heard Jesus say to the angels: “Martin, who is still but a catechumen, clothed me with this robe.” The dream confirmed Martin in his piety, and he was baptized at the age of 18.
