CATHEDRAL 150 MAJOR GIFTS CAMPAIGN

As Parishioners are aware, the Cathedral has been actively raising funds through our Cathedral 150 Campaign, leading up to our 150th Anniversary in 2019. We have now raised over \$250,000 towards our \$400,000 target. We are closing in! The next stage of this initiative is a Major Gifts Campaign. JULY 6th SIR THOMAS MORE (7 February 1478 - 6 July 1535), venerated by Roman Catholics as Saint Thomas More, was an English lawyer, social philosopher, author, statesman and noted Renaissance humanist. He was also a councillor to Henry VIII, and Lord Chancellor from October 1529 to 16 May 1532.

More opposed the Protestant Reformation, in particular the theology of Martin Luther and William Tyndale. He also wrote *Utopia*, published in 1516, about the political system of an ideal and imaginary island nation. More opposed the King's separation from the Roman Catholic Church, refusing to accept him as Supreme Head of the Church of England, and what he saw as Henry's bigamous marriage to Anne Boleyn. Tried for treason for his refusal to condone this, More was convicted and beheaded. "Anglicans remember More in the liturgy, regarding him as a martyr for his conscience during the controversies of the Reformation period".

Fundscrip Explanation

As many of you know, we, like many other sport teams, churches, etc raise funds through the company called **Fundscrip**. This is a great way to generate revenue with very minimal effort on our part.

We thought an explanation of this system might be helpful.

How does this work?

Individuals exchange their cash for store cards which they then use when shopping at that store.

Does this cost the individuals?

No, it is an even swap - cash for store cards.

How does St Peter's make money from this?

The stores give back to us a small percentage (1-5%) of the cards we use in their stores.

Is there a benefit to me as well?

Yes. Each user gets a tax receipt from St Peter's for the amount of that percentage we generated back to the church.

How do I get the store cards?

There are order forms (with a list of the participating stores) at the back of the church to fill out. Hand this form, along with a cheque or cash for the cards you want, to either **Jack Stewart or Bill Leuty**, or into the Church Office. Within one week you will be given the cards you ordered. Then you are free to use them when you shop.

An Example: -

Use an Ultramar card the next time you get gas, use a Starbucks card for your next cup of coffee, or use a grocery store card for some of your grocery shopping, etc. (For every dollar of rebate that you create for St Peter's, you get a tax receipt at the end of the year.)
