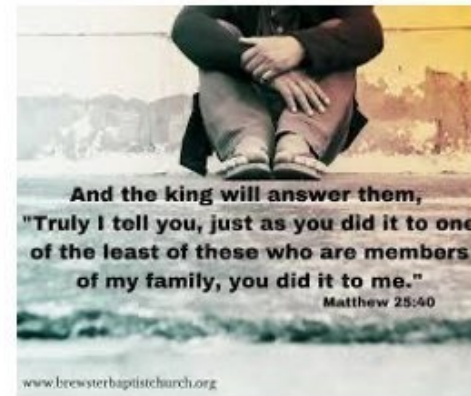
A Big Thank you
