HELP THE PEOPLE OF UKRAINE TODAY

The Primate's World Relief and Development Fund is a member of a Coalition of Churches in Canada and abroad, Anglican, Roman Catholic, Presbyterian, Orthodox, etc., supporting Ukrainians forced to flee their homes due to the Russian invasion and offers humanitarian aid to those still in the Ukraine. The PWRDF has almost no overhead costs and deals directly with churches on the ground.

As the war began on February 24, tens of thousands of Ukrainians fled for safety elsewhere in Ukraine or to neighbouring countries. The Coalition of Churches had already shipped 28 tons of food to support those fleeing to Hungary, and their staff have been working with refugees at the Ukraine/Hungary border.

March 9, 11 & 12 Ember Days are quarterly periods (Latin: quatuor tempora) of prayer and fasting in the liturgical calendar of Western churches. These fasts traditionally take place on the Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday following St Lucy's Day (13 December), the First Sunday in Lent, Pentecost (Whitsun), and Holy Cross Day (14 September), though some areas follow a different pattern. Ordination ceremonies are often held on Ember Saturdays or the following Sunday.
