

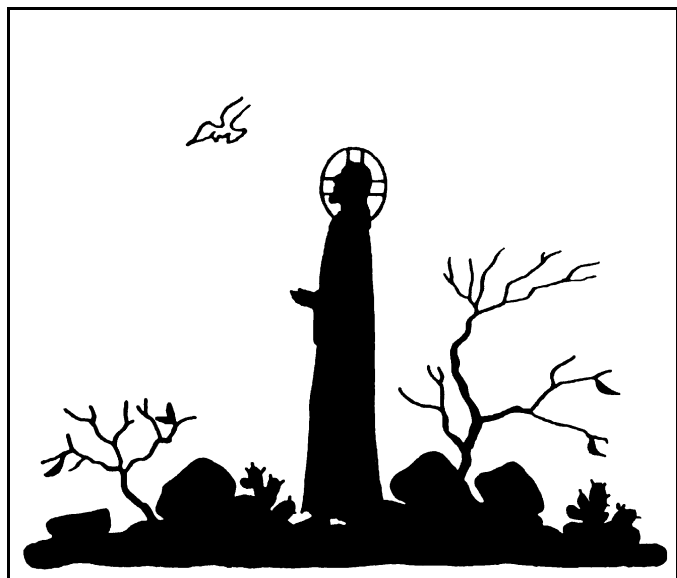

Imposition of Ashes and Holy Eucharist



*“O Lord, who for our sake didst fast forty days and
forty nights:...”*

**Ash Wednesday
February 22, 2023**

When the choir, clergy, and servers have entered, the Priest standing at the Altar will offer the prayers for the Blessing of the Ashes. The clergy, servers, and choir will receive the Imposition of Ashes. Then, while the members of the congregation receive the ashes, the choir will sing the following antiphons and responds:

The Imposition Of Ashes

Let us change our raiment for sack-cloth and ashes: let us fast and mourn before the Lord: for our God is merciful to forgive us our sins.

Antiphon

Juxta Vestibulum

Let the priests, the ministers of the Lord, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say: Spare, O Lord, spare thy people, and shut not up, O Lord, the mouths of them that praise thee.

Emmendemus

1. Let us amend the sins that in our ignorance we have committed: Lest the day of death come upon us suddenly; and we find no place for repentance though we seek it.
2. Hear, Lord, and have mercy: for we have sinned against thee.
