**OCTOBER 16th HUGH LATIMER**, Bishop of Worcester and **NICHOLAS RIDLEY**, Bishop of London, burned at the stake in 1554, during the persecutions of the Roman Catholic Queen Mary for their protestant teaching. Latimer is supposed to have said to Ridley, "Be of good comfort, and play the man, Master Ridley; we shall this day light such a candle, by God's grace, in England, as I trust shall never be put out."

**OCTOBER 17th ETHELDREDA**, Queen of Northumbria and founder of the Abbey of Ely.

**OCTOBER 18th LUKE THE EVANGELIST**. Luke the Evangelist is one of the Four evangelists - the four traditionally ascribed authors of the canonical gospels. The early Church Fathers ascribed to him authorship of both the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles. The New Testament mentions Luke briefly a few times, and the Epistle to the Colossians refers to him as a physician; thus he is thought to have been both a physician and a disciple of Paul.
